WENDOVER AND CHILTERN HILLS LAWN TENNIS AND SQUASH CLUB

The Wendover Tennis and Squash Club is a friendly family orientated club wishing to promote the enjoyment of Tennis, Squash and Racketball. In order to ensure our membership enjoys the Club to the full we have developed formal regulations and a code of practice primarily so that we can work together in ensuring our Club delivers to its principles.

CLUB REGULATIONS

1. General

- a. The Club shall not be responsible to members or their visitors for any loss, damage or injury, whatsoever, to their person, property, personal effects, vehicles, or other items, howsoever caused. If any property of the Club is damaged by any member or their visitor, it shall be the responsibility of that member to make good the damage.
- b. Any Committee member shall have absolute authority to keep order on the courts and any other part of the Club property. Their decision shall be regarded as final.
- c. In the event of wet weather, or for any other reason, members of the Committee may decide that the courts should not be used. The Committee may at their discretion reserve any or all courts for tournaments or other matches.

2. Fees

- a. All fees (match fees, visitors' fees, tournament fees etc.) shall be decided by the Committee and current rates shall be displayed on the tennis notice board.
- b. Members should pay subscriptions in a timely manner in accordance with their agreed payment plan.

3. Membership

- a. All senior and student members shall have full use of courts and Club facilities, except on occasions when club evenings, coaching, matches, etc., may restrict the use of some or all of the courts.
- b. Midweek members can have full use of the courts up until 6.30p.m. but are not entitled to play after 6.30 p.m. or at weekends and do not qualify to represent the Club as member of a team or individually.
- c. Junior members shall have full use of courts and Club facilities until 6.30 p.m. only on weekdays, except on Coaching evenings when Junior Coaching may restrict the use of some or all of the

courts. After 6.30 p.m. and weekends Juniors may use the courts and facilities, however Senior members have priority use of the courts.

- d. Members who invite visitors to play at the Club should ensure the visitors' book is signed and no visitor shall play more than three times in one calendar year. Juniors are not entitled to invite visitors.

Code of Practice

The courts and facilities are available for the enjoyment of all members. It is the responsibility of each member to ensure that the courts are maintained and the facilities are left in a state of tidiness:

- a. No member or visitor shall be allowed on the courts (tennis or squash) unless wearing appropriate shoes and attire.
 - i. Non-marking clean shoes should be worn at all times on the court
 - ii. Suitable attire is that which is suitable to play the appropriate sport without causing offence to fellow players or spectators
- b. The last players to leave the tennis courts should let down the net slightly, ensure the court gates are closed and that the courts and seating area are free of debris/rubbish.
- c. On leaving a squash court the players should check that the court is suitable for the next game.
- d. The last person to leave the Clubhouse should switch off all lights (including men's and ladies changing rooms) and check that all doors are locked.
- e. Anyone using the kitchen facilities should ensure all glasses, mugs, plates etc are washed and put away.

The courts and facilities should not be employed for activities to which they were not designed:

- a. Squash courts are for squash and racketball use only, unless supervised otherwise by an accredited Club coach
- b. Tennis courts are for senior and mini tennis use only, unless supervised otherwise by an accredited Club coach
- c. The Clubhouse facilities are available to spectators and non-playing guests if accompanied by a member or accredited Club coach

The Committee organise Club evenings and from time to time events for the enjoyment of the members:

- a. On Club occasions members are expected to play with any other member.
- b. When all the courts are in use and other members are waiting to play, players should invite those waiting to join in the play at the next convenient point.
- c. The laws of the game shall be those enforced by the LTA and SRRRA.
